

John S. McCain Memorial Scholarship

John S. McCain, a remarkable man with huge accomplishments, served as U.S. Senator and Representative for the State of Arizona. McCain, a Republican, cast the decisive vote to secure the Affordable Care Act. While in the U.S. Navy during the Vietnam war, he survived as a prisoner of war (POW). Often called a 'maverick' while in Congress, he championed LGBT rights, gun regulations and campaign finance reform, among many other issues.

Recipients will receive one full scholarship for a *Grantsmanship Training Program - Online* course and textbook (value \$1,255). Recipients will have 6 months from the date of the award to register and complete the class on the dates of their choice. Applicants must be working with a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization and submit:

- This application
- Documentation of 501(c)(3) status (Determination Letter from the IRS or current 990)
- Organizational budget showing revenue of \$1,000,000 or less. Budget includes revenue & expenses.

Deadline to apply for the 2024-2025 cycle is Friday, November 1, 2024.
